Hello Miss McGlynn.

Wanted to answer your news letter sooner - but just haven't had the chance - today I received your postcard from Marblehead - about the debating club banquet so I thought I ought to get right on the beam and catch up.

Enclosed is a copy of my program of studies - the ones that are checked are the courses I am taking now to be supplemented by a course in Civilian Air Regulations - although I don't know where they are going to put it in our day. This list given you an opportunity to see some of the classes that are being taught here -

We are divided into different groups with the letter denoting over class. As you can see I am in IC which means I will be here for two more months moving out on or about July 15th, class 1B stays here three more months, IA, four months class ID has moved out past week - so we are all moved up a

flight but the length of our stay remains the same.

We expect a new group of "good jets" in tonight - and they will move in as flight 1A - they will stay here five months - each month a new class comes in as an old group moves out - the new group remain as underclassmen for one month.

As you probably know by now - I will not be able to make graduation - while I am very disappointed - I know that my training here is far too valuable to allow them to give me a furlough - while I won't be seeing you all graduation - still I'll be there in feeling - hope all my classmates will be able to march that long last mile -
