### YOM HA'SHOAH READING

Let us pledge to the victims, to ourselves and to the future generations that we will uphold and nourish a commitment to human rights and individual freedoms...that we will watchfully guard this legacy against prejudice and complacency...because the opposite of good is not evil - it is indifference.
