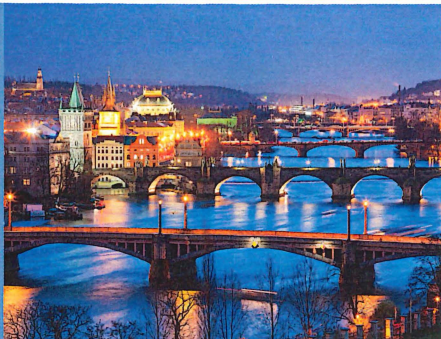
The Holocaust in Central Europe

- **Nuremberg:** (Nuremberg Rally Grounds Interpretation Center/Museum, Zeppelin Field Rally Grounds, Palace of Justice/Nuremberg Trials Museum and Court Room 600)
- **Dachau:** Guided tour of the concentration camp
- **Munich:** Conspiracy of the White Rose Memorial, Munich Documentation Center for Nazi History)
- **Salzburg:** (Locally guided tour for former site of Hitler's Berchtesgaden retreat and new Documentation Center for Nazi History (if completed).)
- **Mauthausen:** Guided tour of the concentration camp
- **Vienna:** (Locally guided walking tour of Jewish Vienna and Holocaust Memorial)
- **Prague:** (Locally guided walking tour of Jewish Prague, faculty-led tour of museum for National Museum of the Heroes of the Heydrich Terror

There will also be free time in each of these exciting cultural cities and capitals to explore culture, music, restaurants and museums.

Price: \$2995 (Double occupancy. Single supplement available for an additional \$711.)
