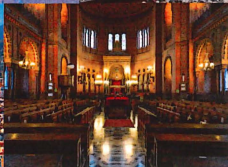

- **Rome:** (Via Rasella, the Ardeatine Caves, Museum of the Historical Liberation of Rome, the Jewish Museum of Rome, National Museum of Palazzo di Venezia. Free day to visit other museums and sites in Rome.
- **Florence:** (Florence American Cemetery and Memorial, Platform 16 Deportation Memorials, Great Synagogue & Jewish Museum. Free day to visit other museums and sites in Florence
- **Genoa, Nice, and Aix-en-Provence:** (Camp des Milles internment and deportation camp). Free day to visit other museums, sites and beaches in Nice)
- **Marseille:** (Memorial des Camps de la Mort, Synagogue Breteuil and tour of the Jewish District. Free day to visit other museums and sites in Marseille)
